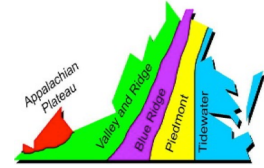


# Virginia's Regions

**Context:** This is a 4<sup>th</sup> grade STEM activity for Social Studies. We study each of the 5 regions; the type of land, the products and industries in each region. Students will review/research a region and its' products and industries.



**Skills Needed:** Ability to use scissors, crayons, markers, and brads. Students also need to understand and apply the concept of pop-ups.

**Goals of Activity:** To create a pop up that is an accurate representation of one of the regions of Virginia. It must include the type of land, products and industries found in that region.

**Literature:** Their textbook and class notes may be used to research the region.

**Time Frame:** Three 30 minute class periods to complete.

**Group Size:** Individual project

**Materials:** Construction paper, tag paper, craft sticks, yarn, miscellaneous material, and any other materials the students want to use that the teacher approves.

**Tools:** Scissors, tape, hole punch, brads, crayons, markers, stapler, Crop-O-Dile,

**Safety Measures:** Review use of safety procedures for provided materials

**Classroom Set-Up:** Materials and tools needed will be on the back counter for all to access. Students will work at their desk, on the floor, or at the back table. Teacher will assist students as they work.

**Background:** You know all the regions of Virginia and you need to teach another student/child about one of the regions.

**Challenge:** Your challenge is to design and create a pop up that represents one region of Virginia. It must include the name of the region, the type of land, at least three products and all the major industries of the region. It must contain at least one moving part. Your design must be neat and creative. You will present your pop up to the class.

## Criteria:

- Label the Region accurately and large enough to be seen
- Land features accurately depicted on the pop up
- Products accurately depicted
- Industries accurately depicted
- One moveable part
- Neat and creative

## Materials:

Construction paper, tag paper, craft sticks, yarn, brads, miscellaneous material, and any other materials the students want to use that the teacher approves.

Scissors, tape, hole punch, crayons, markers, stapler, Crop-O-Dile,

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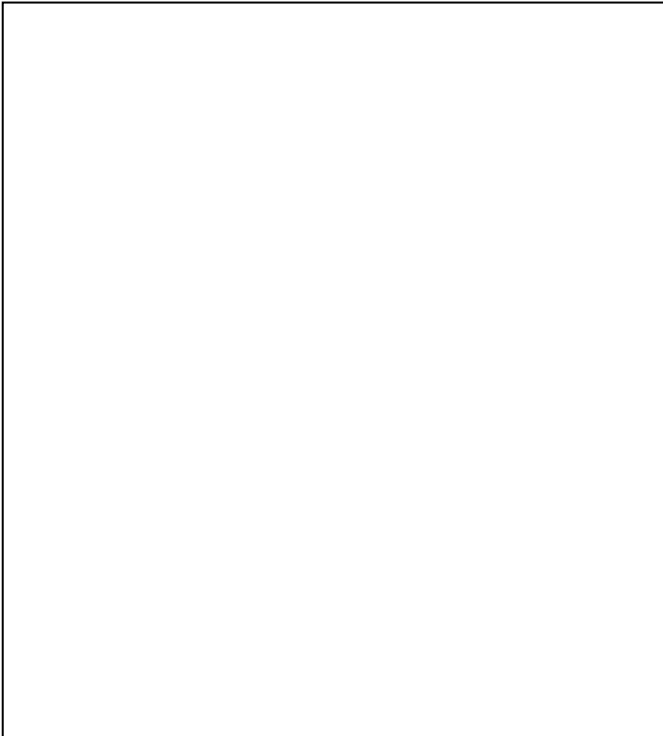
